**OPPORTUNITY** The Head of Global Logistics Shared Services (HGLSS) is a senior management position that will provide solid and stable leadership for a major new initiative focused on supply chain and specifically on logistics. It is a truly global position responsible for regional logistics hubs and their consolidated P&L. The largest portion of the role is to drive major improvements in the logistics systems worldwide whereby the HGLSS has an opportunity to provide significant influence as the designer and builder of the global logistics set-up and infrastructure. The HGLSS will optimize a complex global logistics network while working with and driving change across multiple cultures in Europe, Asia and the Americas.

**RESPONSIBILITY** The HGLSS will be based at the Company's North American Headquarters in Columbus, Ohio and will report directly to the Head of Global Supply Chain Management. From a logistics perspective, this person will also be charged to learn and understand what is currently in place and then define weaknesses and strengths of the system and develop an entire worldwide plan. This will include the responsibility for the logistics hub set up and implementation for Asia Pacific. He/She will not only lead change management in cooperation with the regional heads, but will also be hands on in the field. In addition to the global responsibilities, he/she will provide day-to-day supervision of the Global Supply Chain Management team members based in North America.

**QUALIFICATIONS** The preferred candidate should have at least 10 years of progressive experience in global supply chain management with a minimum of five of those years in logistics management. The preferred candidate should have experience in a multinational manufacturing company whereby a significant portion of the revenue is generated from multiple regions requiring a global logistics and distribution set up. The manufacturing experience should be from a high SKU, discrete environment that has diverse technical products. He/She will demonstrate integrity, be highly ethical in all aspects of business operations and will be accountable for insuring execution of logistics initiatives through performance commitments and expectations.
